Fast, efficient and secure



TIR – the only global transit system

The TIR system enables goods to be shipped from a country of origin to a country of destination in **sealed load compartments**.

TIR offers a **customs declaration and guarantee** for duties and taxes.

By sending advance cargo information to all customs authorities en route, TIR expedites the release of cargo at international borders.

TIR is intermodal and has 78 Contracting Parties.



Efficient and fast

Cut transport times by up to 80% and costs by up to 50%

Manage entire transport operation with a single guarantee and declaration

Receive 24/7 support from IRU and national associations



Cargo securing

Reduce risk of theft, smuggling or other damages

No physical inspection en route

Partner with trustworthy hauliers whose vehicles have been vetted



Transparent and predictable


View status of TIR operation at borders and destination with TIR-EPD

Rely on fixed and predictable transit guarantee payment

Minimise interactions with third parties, perform all customs procedures pre-departure

TIR in Iran

- Facilitate transport of Iranian exports and imports with Türkiye, Europe and CIS countries
- Reduce customs control ratio at Turkish borders under TIR (by 50%) or with TIR Green Lanes in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan
- Cross Iran-Türkiye borders during non-working hours on weekends, non-TIR users must wait until next working day
- Cross borders 2 times faster than non-TIR users
- Reduce costs by up to USD 40 per operation as transit declaration is not required for Azerbaijan and Turkmenistan
- Rely on EUR 100,000 guarantee, and up to EUR 200,000 with TIR+, for customs duties and taxes, not required to escort high-value goods

How to proceed?

Exporters and importers can ensure the security and efficiency of transport by incorporating TIR as a requirement in their tenders or making the use of TIR a condition reflected in contracts with logistics service providers.
